OFFICE OF PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS

The Office of Professional Standards (OPS) investigates or reviews all complaints against the LaGrange Police Department and its employees, use of force incidents, pursuits, conducts internal investigations as assigned by the Chief of Police and conducts video reviews and performance audits.

During 2023, there were 49 Response to Aggression incidents and two complaints of excessive use of force. Both complaints were investigated and unfounded.

OPS conducted five Internal Affairs Investigations involving departmental employees. Of these investigations, four were sustained. A total of 41 citizen complaints were received. Six complaints were sustained with a finding of improper conduct by police department employees.
